Americorps

The AmeriCorps Program at LCSC recruits, trains and places tutors in K-12 schools throughout Northern Idaho, helping students improve academic skills, successfully address the challenges of staying in (or returning to) school, and planning for their futures.

AmeriCorps Vista

The AmeriCorps VISTA Program also operates out of Lewis-Clark Service Corps. Members work on addressing the issue of food insecurity among LCSC students and their families to foster educational attainment and healthy futures.

AmeriCorps Enrollment

AmeriCorps is a national service program, sometimes referred to as a domestic Peace Corps. LCSC students, as well as private individuals may join AmeriCorps. AmeriCorps members serve full-time (1720 hours) or part-time (920 hours) and receive a living allowance while serving, and an Education Award at the successful completion of service that can be used for educational expenses such as fees, tuition and books, or to repay qualified student loans. In addition, Educational Award only positions are available to members serving a minimum of 300 hours. To serve, the prospective member must be a U.S. citizen or legal resident and be at least 17 years old. There is no maximum age limit. Recruitment for members begins in April with the service year beginning September 1 each year
