

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

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Career & Technical Education offers professional and technical training through a formalized array of educational experiences that will prepare individuals for gainful employment as semi-skilled, skilled workers, or technicians in recognized and in new and emerging occupations. It also prepares individuals for enrollment in advanced technical education programs.

Organization

Career & Technical Education programs are organized into units to carry out the role and mission. The Divisions of **Business Technology and Service** and **Technical and Industrial** provide the instructional support for the various programs and degrees. **Workforce Training** provides education and training opportunities in all areas of industry, allied health, professional/business technology, and government agencies. The **Adult Learning Center** provides quality instruction in reading, writing, math, and the English Language to help adults transition into college and/or prepare for the GED tests. The **Learning Resource Center** assists students with study skills and college success strategies. Advanced Opportunities (Formerly Tech-Prep) allows high school students to earn competency based technical college credits for their high school technical coursework. Career & Technical Education offers two Affiliate Programs: Physical Therapist Assistant through North Idaho College and Dental Hygiene through Lane Community College.
